Failure to attend compulsory clarification meeting with the bid document will disqualify the tender. The doors to the venue will be closed at **14h00** and no bidder will be permitted to enter afterwards. Bidders that do not bring the document to the briefing will be disqualified.

Bid documents will not be opened in public however, the results will be published on Mandeni Municipality website. Bids are to be submitted on the bid documentation provided by the Municipality. Late submission, electronic or faxed bids will not be accepted.

Only Bidders registered on Central Supplier Database (CSD) will be considered and must provide proof of registration. The successful bidder will be required to subcontract 30% of the scope to a local contractor.

The Mandeni Municipality subscribes to the preferential procurement policy framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and associated Regulations of 2022. Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the Mandeni Municipality's SCM Policy in two stages. First stage of evaluation is functionality and second stage being price (form of offer). Bids shall be valid for a period of 120 days. The Mandeni Municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest bid, either wholly or in part or give any reason for such action. All bidders must provide audited annual financial statements (AFS) for the past 3 years for companies required by law to be audited. For companies not required by law to be audited, AFS for the past three years or since the date of establishment if established during the past three years. All prospective bidders will be screened in accordance with the National Treasury's Defaulters Data Base. Canvassing in any form in the gift of Council is strictly prohibited and will lead to the disqualification of the bid.
