THE BEAUTIFICATION OF SUNDUMBILI TOWNSHIP ENTRANCE IN WARD 15.

The Mandeni Municipality invites bidders from suitably qualified and experienced contractors for the BEAUTIFICATION OF SUNDUMBILI TOWNSHIP ENTRANCE IN WARD 15. It is estimated that Bidders who are registered with CIDB in a contractor grading of **2SH OR HIGHER** will be eligible to bid. In case of Partnership /Joint Venture a consolidated CIDB Registration Certificate must be attached. Bidders must have proof of CIDB Registration by the closing date failing which their Bid will be disqualified.

Bid documents will only be available at the cashiers, Civic Centre, 2 Kingfisher Road, Mandeni **from Friday, 22 March 2024 until Thursday, 4 April 2024 during working hours: Monday to Friday 08H00 to 15H30.** A non-refundable fee of R 600.00 amount will be charged per document (Cash, debit order or EFT: Ref no.: Bid No. 18/23/24 Bidder's Name). There will be no selling of bid documents after **4th of April 2024 15H30.**

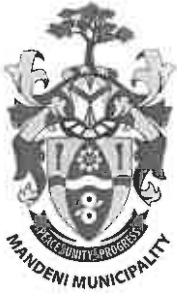
A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at the Tugela Hall, Mandeni on Friday, 5th of April 2024 at 10h00 thereafter proceeding to the site. Failure to attend the compulsory clarification meeting with the bid document will disqualify the tender. The doors to the venue will be closed at **10h00** and no bidder will be permitted to enter afterwards. Bidders that do not bring the document to the briefing will be disqualified.

Bid are to be completed in accordance with the conditions attached to the Bid document and must be sealed in an envelope and marked: **"BID NO.: 18/23/24 BEAUTIFICATION OF SUNDUMBILI TOWNSHIP ENTRANCE IN WARD 15** and must be deposited in the tender box situated at the reception: Civic Centre, 2 Kingfisher Road, Mandeni **no later than 12H00, on Friday, 12th of April 2024** at which time bids will be opened in public. The name and address of the Bidder must be clearly written on the sealed envelope containing the Bid Document. **Late submission, e-mail or fax bids will no circumstances be considered.**

Only bidders registered on Central Supply Data base CSD) will be considered and must provide proof of registration.

The Mandeni Municipality subscribes to the preferential procurement policy framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and its associated Regulations of 2022. All prospective bidders will be screened in accordance with the National Treasury's Defaulters Data Base. Canvassing in any form of gift to Council is strictly prohibited and will lead to the disqualification of the bid.
