Furthermore, in collaboration with the Department of Transport, the Department of Environmental Affairs, Enterprises Ilembe, among others, we have successfully guided over 600 young people through various learnership programs.

The Mobile Library is a service by the Mandeni Local Municipality that brings books, study material and internet to remote areas. It helps the people there to read, learn and use digital tools. The service visits different places and has materials for different ages and interests.

The Youth Office has provided substantial support to the youth within its jurisdiction. Through funding from the National Youth Development Agency (NYDA), the office has facilitated the establishment of entrepreneurial ventures for over thirty young individuals. Additionally, it has contributed to the academic advancement of more than four hundred youths by awarding registration bursaries. The office has also bolstered local sports federations by supplying necessary equipment and offering capacity-building workshops for coaches and referees. Furthermore, the cultural sector has benefited from the office's support of artists via events aimed at sustaining the arts and enhancing festive season celebrations.

### RURAL ROADS

The three-day programme to repair road potholes in rural wards is progressing well. More than 20 km of rural roads have been regavelled so far.

### HIGH MAST LIGHT

The municipality has installed electricity high mast lights in different wards across the Town. The lights aim to improve the safety of residents as well as to improve the quality of life. The high mast lights provide better illumination and visibility at night, reducing the risk of crime and accidents.



### THE ELECTRIFICATION PROJECT

The electrification project of Mandeni local municipality has reached a milestone of 413 households connected to the grid. The project covers various wards, including those in rural areas, and aims to improve the living standards of the residents. The municipality is committed to providing reliable and affordable electricity to its citizens.



### WATER PROJECTS

We appreciate the efforts of our district municipality to provide water to households in the rural areas where water scarcity is a serious problem. We hope that more initiatives will be implemented to solve this issue in the future

# LOCAL ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT



## BUSINESS FUNDING & SUPPORT

The Quick win funding program has benefited more than 500 SMMEs in the local area. Additionally, 10 entrepreneurs received Entrepreneur Support Funding to start or grow their businesses. The program also assisted 200 informal traders, such as tuckshop owners, with financial and technical support. Furthermore, three co-operatives were equipped with fishing gear to boost their income. The program also helped 50 businesses to register formally and 46 contractors to obtain NHBRC certificates and training.



## BUSINESS PERMITS

- We granted 500 trading Permits to the local vendors and Tuckshops in our area, enabling them to operate legally and safely.
- We issued 150 Business licenses to various enterprises, facilitating their growth and development.
- We supported 50 Agricultural Businesses with essential materials and equipments, enhancing their productivity and sustainability.



## ANNUAL SMME FAIR

Our SMME Fair and Exhibition gave an opportunity to more than 30 local small businesses to display their products to potential customers and partners.

## RAND FOR RAND

The Mandeni Local Municipality has launched an initiative titled the "Rand for Rand" campaign. This program offers residents a rebate matching the precise sum of money they remit towards their outstanding Municipal Account balance. For instance, should a resident settle an amount of R1000 on their arrears, the municipality will correspondingly allocate an additional R1000 to their account.

## WASTE MANAGEMENT

The Mandeni Local Municipality conducts waste collection services on a weekly basis. The designated routes and specific areas for waste collection are delineated as follows:

**Monday:** Tugela Mouth Village North bound and Sundumbili skips in ward 2, ward 7 and ward 15

**Tuesday:** Municipal Main Offices, BP Garage, Mandeni Shopping Centre, SAPPI Village, SAPPI Flats, Starting from Long Road down Anderson Road until Umfolozi College up to Whimbrel Road and Trogon Road in ward 3

**Wednesday:** King Fisher Road, Robin Place, Patrys Road and all Surrounding Roads up to Kudu Road down Impunzi Road via Gazzelle Road to Inyathi Road and all Surrounding Roads, Technical Services Office down Acacia Road and all Surrounding Roads until Lalanathi Guest House in ward 3

**Thursday:** Skips in Hlomendlini, Fort Pearson Nature Reserve, Tugela Mouth South Bound and Bins at Schools and Clinic in ward 4

**Friday:** Padianagar, Emathankeni, Ehholo, Sphekephekeni, Eblokisin, Ezinsimbini, High View Park, Newtown, Newark CBD and Nova's Farm.

**Saturday:** Renckens Hyperstore, Mandeni CBD, Mandeni Police Station, BP Garage, Municipal Main Office, Lalanathi Guest House and any other Business as per request

**Sunday:** Dokodweni beach, Tugela Mouth beach, Mandeni CBD, Renckens Hyperstore and any outstanding waste collection.

The municipal authority provides waste collection services on a weekly basis. It should be noted that garden refuse is not included in these services. Members of the community are required to visit the municipal offices to make arrangements for the payment and subsequent collection of such waste.
