Bidders are hereby invited from suitable service providers for a maximum panel of (3) service providers to assist with tyre supply, fitment, repairs, and conduct alignment on plant and equipment Light and Heavy duty vehicles for a period of 3 years as and when required by Mandeni Local Municipality.

Bids are to be completed in accordance with the conditions attached to the Bid document and must be sealed in an envelope and marked: **"BID NO: 18/24/25 AND Establishment of Panel Of Maximum of Three (3) Service Providers for the Supply, Repair And Deliver Tyres For Light And Heavy Duty Vehicles For Three (3) Years As And When Required**, and must be deposited in the tender box situated at the reception: Civic Centre, 2 Kingfisher Road, Mandeni **no later than 12H00, on Monday, 24<sup>th</sup> of March 2025** at which time bids will be opened in public. Closing time will **only** be determined by the Municipal watch displayed on the Municipal wall at the reception. The name and address of the Bidder must be clearly written on the sealed envelope containing the Bid Document. **Late submission, e-mail or fax bids will no circumstances be considered. Only bidders registered on Central Supply Database (CSD) will be considered.**

The Mandeni Municipality subscribes to the preferential procurement policy framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000 and its associated Regulations of 2022. Bids will be evaluated and adjudicated in terms of the Mandeni Municipality's SCM Policy in two stages. First stage of evaluation is functionality and second stage being price (form of offer). Bids shall be valid for a period of 120 days. The Mandeni Municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest bid, either wholly or in part or give any reason for such action. All prospective bidders will be screened in accordance with the National Treasury's Defaulters Data Base.
